You've got the outfit planned...now what? There are lots to consider when getting your pictures done. While everyone has their own method of preparation, I can definitely give you some insider tips for how to prepare and make sure your senior photo shoot is a smashing success.

PLAN AHEAD

Several months before your session -- two or three, give or take -- is the best time to start thinking about the big day. Start a Pinterset board, start dog-earing magazine pages and definitely start trying on various clothing to see what you feel best in. As the day gets closer, start narrowing down your inspiration boards and idea. That includes outfits, hair and makeup for women, and even props.

SAMPLE SCHEDULE:
